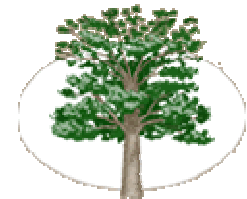
Visit the Mackay Regional Botanic Gardens

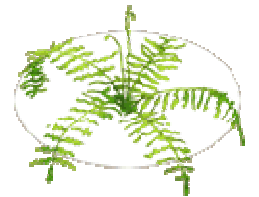
